SPECIAL ELECTIONS

NORTH FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP LEVY ELECTION

Shall North Franklin Township be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed 10 cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in excess of the limits prescribed by law until fiscal year 2026-2027 for the purposes of general operations?

A vote Yes on the issue grants authority to North Franklin Township to exceed statutory levy limits as described above.

A vote No does not grant such authority to North Franklin Township.

There will be one (1) Proposed Constitutional Amendment and two (2) Proposed Initiative Petition Measures to be voted upon at the General Election. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the Proposed Constitutional Amendment and Proposed Initiative Petition Measures once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the General Election. The publication will be a true copy of the title and text of each measure to be submitted.

I, Marcia Volk Schenker, County Clerk of Franklin County, Nebraska do hereby certify that the persons whose names are printed in this certification have made personal filings and each has fulfilled all requirements of law and each is entitled to have their name printed upon the official ballot as a candidate for public office as designated in the certification.
