

Road Closure descriptions Franklin Township

A Road known as Road #299 in Supervisors minutes, platted in a meeting held on April 27, 1909 as noted in Book 7, Page 76 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately 40 rods in length commencing at the southeast corner of Section One (1), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. proceeding north and which lies along the east side of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE1/4, SE1/4) of Section One (1), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast of the 6th P.M. and the west side of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (SW1/4, SW1/4) of Section Six (6), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-eight (38) Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #68 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held October 7, 1879 as noted in Book 2, Page 250 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately Five (5) miles in length which lies along the half mile line running north and south commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. proceeding north through Sections Thirty-four (34), Twenty-seven (27), Twenty-two (22), Fifteen (15), and Ten (10), terminating at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road described in an unknown location in the Commissioners Records on file, but displayed on the Road Plat maps in the Clerk's office of the Franklin County Courthouse having been established on November 10, 1885, being hereby described as being approximately one (1) mile in length, which lies along the east side of Section Seven (7), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14) West of the 6th P.M., and along the west side of Section Eight (8), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-three (33) Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #73 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held November 10, 1885 as noted in Book 2, Page 582 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately One half (1/2) mile in length which lies along the north side of the Northwest quarter of Section Eighteen (18), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the south side of the Southwest quarter of Section Seven (7), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of E Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #146 in Supervisors minutes, platted in a meeting held on December 28, 1915 as noted in Book 7, Page 306 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of pubic road approximately One-half (½) mile in length which lies along the north side of the Northeast quarter of Section Sixteen (16), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the south side of the Southeast quarter of Section Nine (9), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of E Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #345 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held on August 19, 1917 as noted in Book 7, Page 356 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of pubic road approximately One (1) mile in length which lies along the east side of Section Fourteen (14), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of Section Thirteen (13), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-seven (37) Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.


A Road known as Road #134 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held July 12, 1893 as noted in Book 3, Page 421 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately Two (2) miles in length which lies along the west side of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the east side of Section Nine (9), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and on the east side of Section Sixteen (16), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of Section Fifteen (15), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of Section Fifteen (15), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of the 6th P.M. all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-five (35) Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #74 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held May 1, 1880 as noted in Book 2, Page 275 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately One (1) mile in length which lies along the north side of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the south side of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. ALSO,

That portion of public road approximately One (1) mile in length which lies along the north side of Section Twenty-five (25), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the south side of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #75 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held May 1, 1880 as noted in Book 2, Page 275 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately One (1) mile in length which lies along the east side of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of Section Thirty-five (35), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-six (36) Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #281 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held September 25, 1886 as noted in Book 7, Page 13 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately One (1) mile in length which lies along the south side of Section Twenty-eight (28) Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M. and the north side of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of B Road, as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

Road Closure descriptions Washington Township

All roads are in Franklin County, Nebraska

A Road described in the Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held on December 11, 1903 as noted in Book 5, Page 116 of Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately one half (½) mile in length which lies along the east side of the northeast quarter of Section Four (4), Township One (1), Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M. and the west side of the Northwest quarter of Section Three (3), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Forty-one (41) Road as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

ALSO; That portion of public road approximately one (1) mile in length which lies on the north side of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M. and the south side of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of B Road as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein. ALSO; That portion of public road approximately Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty (4260) feet in length, commencing at the Southwest corner of Section thirty-two (32), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M. thence running north and which lies on the east side of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-one (31), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and the west side of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirtytwo (32), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and the east side of the Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-one (31), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and the west side of the Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of Thirty-nine (39) Road as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #47 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held July 3, 1877 as noted in Book 2, Page 122 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately three quarter (¾) miles in length, commencing at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence running southwest to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE1/4, NW1/4) of said Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence running east to the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE1/4, NW1/4) of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and which lies all within the Northwest quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and which lies all within the Northwest quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road named Road #36 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held January 4, 1876 as noted in Book 2, Page 31 of Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road approximately one-half $\binom{1}{2}$ mile in length which lies along the north side of the Southwest

quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and along the south side of the Northwest quarter of Section Ten (10), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, being a portion of EF Road as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #19 in the Road Plat map in the Franklin County Clerk's office on file. That portion of public road approximately one (1) mile in length, commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section Fourteen (14), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13) West of the 6th P.M., thence running north approximately one quarter (¼) mile, thence northeasterly and thence northwesterly, thence running north approximately one quarter (¼) mile, terminating near the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Section Fourteen (14), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., and which lies all with the East one half of Section Fourteen (14) Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13) West of the 6th P.M.

ALSO; That portion of public road approximately (½) mile in length, commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence running north approximately one quarter (¼) mile, thence northwesterly and then northeasterly, terminating at a point approximately 600 feet East and 600 feet North of the Center of Section Eleven (11), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., at the southern point of the vacation of the northern portion of same road on the Road Plat map in Franklin County Clerk's office on file, all of which lies within the West half of Section Eleven (11), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

ALSO; That portion of public road approximately Three (3) miles in length commencing at the Northwest corner of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence running Southeasterly to a point near the center of Section Twenty-five (25), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence southwesterly, thence southeasterly to a point near the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (SE1/4, NE1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence Southwest corner of the South to the Southwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., thence Southwest corner of the south to the Southwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #53 ½, in the Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held January 4, 1876 as noted in Book 2, Page 32 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road one (1) mile in length which lies on half section line running east and west through the center of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13), West of the 6th P.M., all in Franklin County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and by that reference fully incorporated herein.

A Road known as Road #331 in Supervisors minutes, opened in a meeting held August 21, 1913 as noted in Book 7, Page 235 of the Commissioners Records on file. That portion of public road
